- (A) Analyse the poem *London* by Samuel Johnson as a satire.
- (B) How does Johnson's poem *London* present a sharp critique of the Augustan celebration of urban life and culture through its description of the city?
- (C) Give an account of the quiet countryside painted by Thomas Grey in his poem *Elegy Written in a Country Churchyard*.
- (D) Explore the romantic qualities already foreshadowed in Grey's *Elegy Written in a Country Churchyard*.
