Based on the provided data from a parent-teacher meeting (PTM), the responses from parents regarding their experience can be interpreted in several key ways. Here's a detailed interpretation of the data:

Positive Reception


A significant majority of parents, 90 out of the total respondents, reported that they found the PTM to be "good." This indicated a strong positive reception among the parent community, suggesting that the meeting met or exceeded their expectations. The "good" response likely reflects parents' satisfaction with various aspects of the PTM, including the organization, communication, and the quality of interactions with teachers.

Adequate Satisfaction

A smaller, yet notable, group of parents, 28 respondents, described their experience as "satisfactory." While these parents did not rate the PTM as "good," their "satisfactory" rating indicated that the meeting met the basic requirements and fulfilled its purpose, though there were areas that need to be improved. This feedback is valuable as it suggested that while the overall reception is positive, there is room for enhancement in certain areas to elevate these satisfactory experiences to good ones.

The combined data shows that out of the total 118 respondents, approximately 76.3% rated the PTM as "good," and 23.7% rated it as "satisfactory." This distribution reflects a generally positive trend, with a clear majority of parents being pleased with the PTM. However, it also highlighted that nearly a quarter of parents see potential for improvement.


Positive Feedback Loop


Significant Minority Expresses Dissatisfaction

Limited Preference for Online Learning




Intermittent Internet Access
