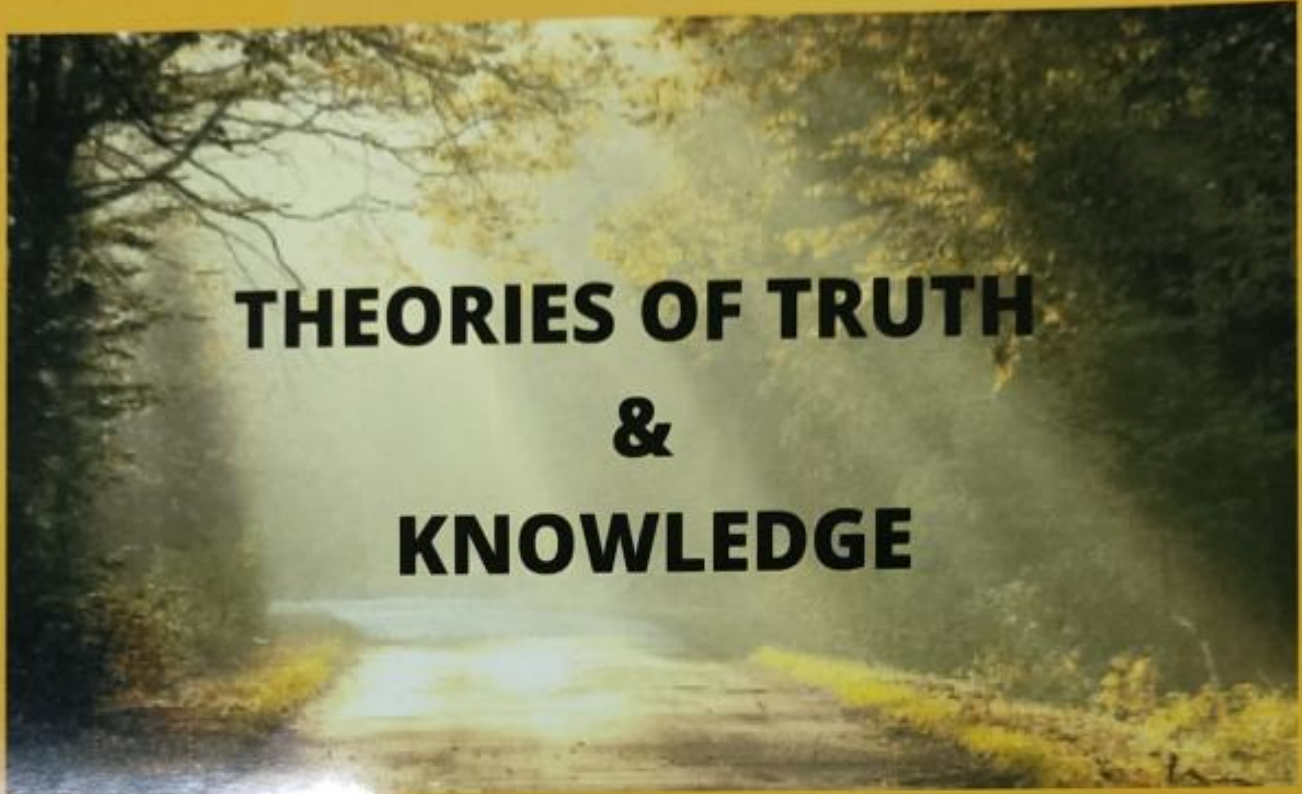

ABOUT THE SEMINER

Philosophy is a matter of study which deals with several things. It is not only a study of critical thinking but it also evokes the theory of Truth and Knowledge. The meaning of the term 'Knowledge' connected with the literal meaning of the term 'Philosophy' means - Wisdom. So Wisdom implies Knowledge. Knowledge is collection of everything like the Knowledge of the world, Knowledge of life, Knowledge of human etc. On the other hand Truth means - Real or Absolute. He welcomed everyone to the webinar and showed the importance of this programme. The introductory speech was given by Dr. Ranjini Basu , Head Department of Philosophy Kishore Bharati Bhagini Nivedita College (co-ed) Where the importance of this topic was explicitly narrated .



The One day International webinar started with the key-note address speech on Theories of Truth and Knowledge by Professor Sirajul Islam Professor and Former Head Dept of Philosophy Visva Bharati University. He said his introductory speech that – The discussion happened truth and knowledge it is just like a vast ocean there are innumerable theories throughout the globe .Like From Indian perspectives from Western Perspectives and various other schools of Philosophy on before the advent of Plato and Aristotle even sophist they also discussed concerning the truth and knowledge. In Indian philosophy there are also various schools they have very significantly discuss various aspect of knowledge and truth. He said that – In his view point it is appropriate to say that discussion upon truth and knowledge rather I will be much discuss upon knowledge and truth. Knowledge for particularly aware the real truth therefore there are various schools they have discussed on knowledge . Before the advent from modern civilization Indian saints and seers also have made a pivotal role of discussion of knowledge and truth. From Indian perspectives we can say knowledge is equivalent to jnana. Jnana means knowing the yoga . In Indian perspectives there are four types f yoga . Among them jnana yoga is very important. In Upanishad of jnnana kanda specially discuss concerning knowledge. Knowledge means – Truth , Sense organs . Apart from that Indian Perspectives particularly the means of knowledge is two types –para vidya –higher category of knowledge A para vidya –Related to mundane or phenomenal aspect of the world

Lastly we can define knowledge is mainly two kinds – direct knowledge and indirect knowledge.

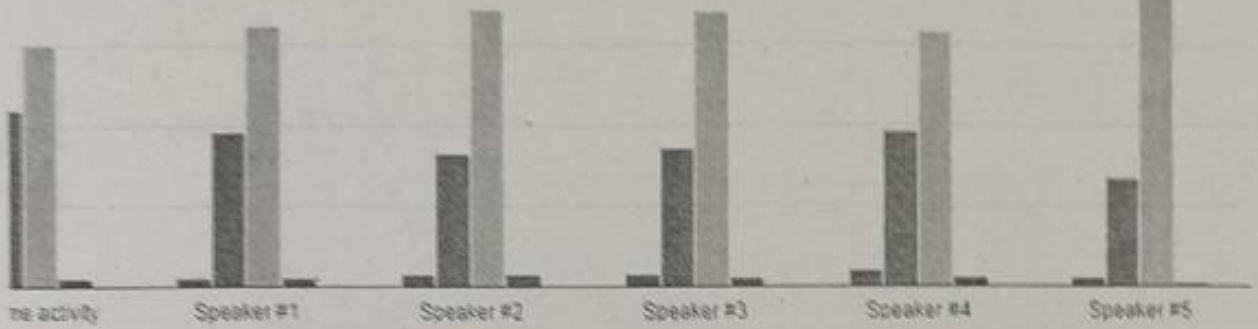
When Indirect knowledge going into the higher stages it is known as prajna or wisdom or Nosis . From Vedanta concept jnana or knowledge actually means –self realization . This self realization helpful for attain the highest knowledge . Next he discussed on western perspective. He said from western perspective the branches of epistemology basically tried to establish –what is knowledge . According to Plato in his Theaetetus he had composed 36 dialogues. Theaetetus basically discussed concerning the possibility of knowledge. Plato finally go to the conclusion that true belief or justified belief is the source of knowledge. knowledge help us to attained truth that's why it is not false what id truth . There are various philosophical theories in western philosophy. They have discussed concerning the truth and that also the theory of knowledge. There are correspondence theory, Coherence theory , and pragmatic

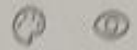
