




FIGURE 6 - HEALTH CHECK-UP CAMP, 06.01.2021

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




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## FIGURE 11 – INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION, 15.08.2022




FIGURE 12 - COLLABORATION WITH INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CELEBRAL PALSY,23.11.2022



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


FIGURE 13 - PROGRAM ON AGNI - VEER PROJECT, 30.11.2022

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




FIGURE 15 – GENDER SENSITIZATION, 27.3.2023

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## REPORT ON NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS), KBBNC


NSS in an Indian government sponsored unit under the ministry of Sports & Youth Affairs. It was launched in 1969 to build the character of students and younger generations via community services. NSS helps the students develop appreciation to other person's point of view and also show consideration to other living beings. 24th September is celebrated every year as NSS Day and the symbol for the NSS has been based on the giant Rath Wheel of the world famous Konark Sun Temple situated in Orissa, India. The motto of NSS 'Not Me But You', reflects the essence of democratic living and upholds the need for self-less service.

NSS helps in overall nurturing of an individual's personality and makes them more skillful. It also enables an individual to acclimatize to situations involving people from different works of life. It also gives them opportunity to explore as well as participate in various Nation building activities.

The NSS unit of our college conducts regular and special camps, awareness classes, personality development programs, demonstrations etc. for the volunteers. In the process an individual learns how to respond and act in case of natural calamities in order to help common mass. They also learn to provide first aid to the victims of natural disasters like floods, landslides, earthquakes etc.
