

Action Taken On The Major Observation and on the basis of Report (2022-2023)

- College ambience: understanding the need of having a livelier campus, we have already painted the entire building in colourful hues, had more lights installed for a brighter feel and planted more greens all around the limited space available.
- Library Books we have over 5500 books in the library and access to n list. However since it is never enough to own more, we plan to continue with annual allotment for all departments to buy more relevant and reference books for their subjects.
- Library Sitting arrangements- to make up for the lack of space in sitting arrangements, we plan to take up some more space in the corridor and transform it into a library sitting area.
- Cleanliness we already have increased personnel assisting our main sweeper. We do keep the campus clean round the clock. We also try spreading awareness among students through orientation and by hanging posters and flexes about keeping their campus clean. Also we follow the KMC arrangement about typecasting and disposing off of wastes of different types.
- Availability of rooms we have plans for restructuring and mending the damaged part of the building in a bid to increase the available number of rooms.
- Offline classes students and their parents both prefer the normal interactive classroom studies as opposed to online method that had started during the covid pandemic. We in college being mindful of such things take regular classes to help us finish the syllabi. Also various extracurricular activities are encouraged in the offline mode to keep students interested in studies.
- College website is updated at regular intervals to keep a transparency between the college and its students.
- Furniture of classroom our classrooms are freshly painted, armed with better electrical fittings and most of them have been ICT enabled. Furniture is constantly upgraded in our institute.

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- Designing & developing of courses We do have a lot of leeway in designing our Add on courses in the college.
- PTM being an effective method of communication between guardians and teachers, we love having them. We plan to have them both pre and post exams.
- Blended learning in case of blended learning online method only supplements class room teaching. Also internet access for resources has long been in use.
- Internet access/ wi-fi we have good access throughout the college premises. We plan to further strengthen the same.
- Orientation- exam related, 1st day in the college this would keep students updated about the course of actions to be taken and hence we plan to do it more often.
- Students seminar, activities students enthusiastically participate in these extra curriculars. But we plan to bring in more willing students into the purview.
- Strictness regarding attendance of students the University has done away with this. But we plan to still have strict rules regarding attendance.
- Classroom separate from laboratories- the science stream needs separate classrooms. We have provided some. We plan to expand the scope soon.
- A ramp for wheelchair has already been made and wheelchairs have been bought. We also have provision for construction of lift.
- > Acs will soon be bought for most important rooms in the building.
- Canteen we have plans for upgradation of our canteen, but our canteen has a lot of provisions already

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Actions Taken Report (2021-2022)

1. College Ambience

To enhance the overall ambience of the college, the authorities undertook several initiatives aimed at creating a more welcoming and stimulating environment. Landscaping projects were on process to beautify the campus with well-maintained small garden. Artistic pictures and walls were coloured recently to beautify the ambience of the college. 2. Library Books
